AN ACT FOR THE DETECTION AND CONTROL OF THE DUTCH ELM DISEASE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To protect the American elms within
2 the commonwealth from the ravages of the fungus
3 known as the Dutch elm disease, it is hereby recog-
4 nized that the personnel and facilities of the Dutch
5 Elm Disease Laboratory at the state college should
6 be enlarged.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act there is
2 hereby appropriated the sum of _____ dollars.
