## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES IN THE OFFICIAL SERVICE CLASSIFICATION OF CIVIL SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The positions of storeroom helpers in the division  
2 of employment security of the department of labor  
3 and industries shall, upon the effective date of this  
4 act, be placed in the official service classification of  
5 civil service. The persons employed in such positions  
6 on said effective date and having a permanent or a  
7 permanent recurrent status under the civil service  
8 laws shall continue to serve in such positions and  
9 their tenure of office shall be unlimited, subject,  
10 however, to the civil service laws, and subject to their  
11 passing a non-competitive qualifying examination  
12 to be given by the division of civil service. Persons  
13 who do not pass such an examination shall continue  
14 to be employed in their present positions, but shall  
15 not be subject to said laws so far as they apply to  
16 said official service.
