AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MAILING OF ABSENT VOTING
BALLOTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 93, as most recently amended
3 by section 8 of chapter 722 of the acts of 1941, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following section:—
5 *Section 93.* All ballots cast under section ninety-
6 two which are not required to be mailed to the city or
7 town clerk shall be delivered to such clerk before the
8 day of election and all other ballots cast thereunder
9 shall be mailed to the city or town clerk so as to be
10 received by such clerk not later than six o'clock post
11 meridian on the day before the election or, when the
12 election is to be held on a Monday, not later than noon
13 of the day of election.
