By Mr. Casey of Taunton, petition of Francis X. Casey that the time be extended for the prosecution of claims against the city of Taunton for certain land damages. Judiciary.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE PROSECUTION OF CLAIMS AGAINST THE CITY OF TAUNTON FOR CERTAIN LAND DAMAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The time during which claims may be
2 made and legal proceedings commenced against the
3 city of Taunton for the taking of the land of any per-
4 son or for damages to property sustained by any per-
5 son in connection with the construction of Camp
6 Myles Standish and of any and all ways leading thereto
7 is hereby extended for a period of one year from the
8 date of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the mayor and council of the city of
3 Taunton.

Organization of the Department

The Department is organized as follows:

1. The Department is headed by the Director, who is responsible for the overall management and administration of the Department.

2. The Department is divided into several sections, each headed by a Section Head, who reports to the Director.

3. Each section is further divided into several units, each headed by a Unit Head, who reports to the Section Head.

4. The Department also has a number of staff positions, which are responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Department.

5. The Department is also responsible for the recruitment and selection of staff, and for the training and development of staff.

6. The Department is also responsible for the financial management of the Department, and for the preparation of the Department's budget.
