In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE JUSTICES OF CERTAIN COURTS, AND REQUIRING THEM TO SERVE AS FULL TIME JUSTICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 76 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 600 of the acts of
3 1946, is hereby further amended by adding at the
4 end the following:— The salaries of the justices of
5 the following courts, who shall devote all of their
6 time and effort to the performance of their duties as
7 such, and who shall not accept other compensation
8 from any person for services performed by them, shall
9 severally be as follows:— Third district court of
10 eastern Middlesex, nine thousand dollars; second
11 district court of eastern Middlesex, seventy-five hun-
12 dred dollars; municipal court of the Roxbury district,
13 nine thousand dollars.
