AN ACT EXEMPTING EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE AGREEMENTS FROM THE MINIMUM WAGE STATUTE.

- 4 Section 20B. No employer shall be deemed to have
- 5 violated any directory or mandatory order by paying
- 6 less than the minimum wage prescribed therein, if
- 7 such payment is in pursuance of an agreement with
- 8 his employees covering a definite period of time; pro-
- 9 vided, that the average rate of payment during said
- 10 period is not less than the minimum prescribed in
- 11 said order.
