AN ACT PROVIDING FOR GUARD RAILS TO THE PITS AT STATIONS OF THE BOSTON ELEVATED RAILWAY COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, all pits occupied by rails of the Boston Elevated
3 Railway Company, at stations where the trains of
4 said company propelled by third rail stop, shall be
5 guarded with rails or fences with suitable gates for
6 entrance and exit to and from the trains.
