AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE MAKING AND EXHIBITING OF
A MODEL RELIEF MAP OF THE BATTLE OF BUNKER HILL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission
2 is hereby authorized and directed to have made by a
3 competent expert a model relief map of the Battle of
4 Bunker Hill, showing in miniature detail the condi-
5 tions as they existed on June seventeenth, seventeen
6 hundred and seventy-five, including the lines of forti-
7 fications, vessels in the harbor and the placement of
8 troops, such map to be placed permanently on exhi-
9 bition in a proper case provided for that purpose in
10 the museum at the foot of the Bunker Hill Monument.

1 SECTION 2. The cost of making such model relief
2 map and case and all other expenses incurred in carry-
3 ing out the provisions of this act shall not exceed, in
4 the aggregate, twenty-five hundred dollars.
