By Mr. Wood of Easton, petition of Bernard A. Cabisius and others for the election or appointment of an appropriation, advisory or finance committee by the town of Norton. Towns.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT OF AN APPROPRIATION, ADVISORY OR FINANCE COMMITTEE BY THE TOWN OF NORTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Norton, notwithstanding
2 the provisions of section sixteen of chapter thirty-
3 nine of the General Laws, may provide by by-law for
4 the election of an appropriation, advisory or finance
5 committee, as well as for the appointment of such a
6 committee under said section sixteen, and such a
7 committee so elected shall have the same powers and
8 duties as a committee appointed under said section
9 sixteen. Any vote or any by-law of said town author-
10 izing the election of such a committee passed or
11 adopted prior to the effective date of this act, and all
12 acts done by a committee so elected, are hereby con-
13 firmed and made valid to the same extent as if this

14 act had been in effect at the time of the passage of
15 such vote or the adoption of such by-law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by a majority of the registered voters of
3 the town of Norton voting thereon at the annual
4 town meeting in the year nineteen hundred and forty-
5 seven, or at a special town meeting held thereafter,
6 but not otherwise.
