AN ACT ALLOWING THE POLICE COMMISSIONER OF THE CITY OF BOSTON TO PROMOTE TO THE NEXT HIGHEST GRADE POLICE OFFICERS WHO HAVE BEEN AWARDED THE WALTER SCOTT MEDAL FOR VALOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of General Laws,
2 Tercentenary Edition, chapter thirty-one, as amended,
3 or any regulation made thereunder the police com-
4 missioner of the city of Boston is hereby authorized
5 to promote to the next highest grade or rank any
6 police officer who has been awarded the Walter Scott
7 medal for valor.
