RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO ENACT INTO LAW A CERTAIN ACT KNOWN AS THE "MERRIMACK VALLEY AUTHORITY ACT".

1 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts
2 memorializes the congress of the United States to
3 enact into law a certain act being H. R. 7175 filed on
4 July 26, 1946 in the 2nd Session of the 79th Congress
5 to establish a Merrimack Valley Authority to provide
6 for unified water control and resource development on
7 the Merrimack River and surrounding region in the
8 interest of the control and prevention of floods, the
9 promotion of navigation and reclamation of the public
10 lands, the promotion of family-type farming, the de-
11 velopment of the recreational possibilities and the
12 promotion of the general welfare of the area, the
13 strengthening of the national defence, and for other
14 purposes; and be it further

15 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be trans-
16 mitted forthwith by the state secretary to the Presi-
17 dent of the United States, to the presiding officers of
18 each branch of Congress, and to the members thereof
19 from this commonwealth.
