By Mr. Ellis of Barnstable, petition of Henry A. Ellis that the Commonwealth be authorized to reimburse owners of shore front property in the town of Barnstable for work done in providing shore protection. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT TO INCLUDE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE REIMBURSEMENT OF OWNERS OF SHORE FRONT PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter seven hundred and thirty-four of the acts
2 of nineteen hundred and forty-five is hereby amended
3 by the addition thereto of the following section as
4 section 5:—

5 *Section 5.* The provisions hereinbefore set forth in
6 sections one, two, three and four of this act are hereby
7 extended to include and to authorize the reimburse-
8 ment of owners of shore front property in the town of
9 Barnstable for such shore protective work done, in
10 process or contracted for between July twenty-fifth,
11 nineteen hundred and forty-four and December
12 thirty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-six.
