AN ACT TO RE-ESTABLISH BELLE ISLE INLET TO ITS NATURAL FUNCTION AS A NAVIGABLE WATERWAY AND SEA-SCOUR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is  
2 herewith authorized to expend the sum of five million  
3 dollars to widen and deepen Belle Isle inlet from Chel-  
4 sea creek to Boston Inner harbor.

1 SECTION 2. The sum shall be procured by the issue  
2 of state bonds running for ten years at an interest rate  
3 of four and one half per cent per annum.

1 SECTION 3. The work shall be completed within  
2 three years. There shall be a nominal toll charge  
3 placed against all registered craft using this passage.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
