AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN POLICIES WITHOUT CONTINGENT LIABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after section 93F thereof the following
- 3 new section:—
- 4 *Section 93G.* Any company which is authorized to
- 5 issue non-assessable policies under the provisions of
- 6 section eighty-five A, section ninety-three F or sec-
- 7 tion one hundred and fifty-two A, may state, in
- 8 any such policy or on the filing back thereof, or in any
- 9 such policy and on the filing back thereof, that such
