AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NO INSURANCE AGENTS, ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENTS OR ASSISTANT MANAGERS SHALL BE CHARGED WITH A DECREASE OR DEDUCTION FROM HIS COMMISSION OR SALARY ON INDUSTRIAL LIFE INSURANCE POLICIES LAPSED AFTER BEING PAID ON FOR THREE YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 164A, inserted by chapter 226
3 of the acts of 1943, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section:—

5 *Section 164A.* If a policy of industrial life insurance
6 upon which premiums have been paid for three years
7 or more is surrendered to the company for a cash sur-
8 render value or paid up insurance or extended term
9 insurance or lapses for non-payment of premiums, the
10 agents, assistant superintendents or assistant managers
11 shall not be charged with a decrease for said premium
12 and no deduction shall be made from his commission
13 or salary.
