AN ACT REPEALING A PROVISION OF THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW RELATIVE TO REFERENCE OF CERTAIN CASES UNDER SUCH LAW TO INDUSTRIAL DISEASE REFEREES WHICH HAS BEEN DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section nine B of chapter one hundred and fifty-two
2 of the General Laws, as inserted by chapter four hun-
3 dred and twenty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred
4 and thirty-five, and as amended by chapter four hun-
5 dred and sixty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred
6 and thirty-eight, is hereby repealed.
