AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PROVING OF WILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 192 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following: —
4 provided, that no will shall be proved by any such
5 witness or by the affidavit of any such witness until
6 after the return day of the petition for the probate
7 thereof and until all interested persons have received
8 actual notice of the filing of the same or such other
9 notice as the court may order.
