Dullea for legislation to authorize the inclusion in the state retirement system of former members of the General Court who prior or subsequent thereto were in the employ of the Commonwealth or one or more of its political subdivisions. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE INCLUSION IN THE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF FORMER MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT WHO PRIOR OR SUBSEQUENT THERETO WERE IN THE EMPLOY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OR ONE OR MORE OF ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any person who was a member of the general court
2 and prior or subsequent thereto, or both, was in the
3 employ of the commonwealth or of one or more of its
4 political subdivisions, for a total period of not less
5 than twenty years may, upon his written request,
6 become a member of the state retirement system, and
7 thereupon shall be entitled to all the privileges of
8 membership therein; and upon his retirement from
9 the service shall be entitled to a retirement benefit
10 totalling not less than two-thirds of the salary re-
11 ceived by him at the time of his retirement.
