AN ACT ESTABLISHING MINIMUM COMPENSATION FOR PROBATION OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 83 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 186 of the acts
3 of 1937, is hereby further amended by adding at the
4 end the following sentence:— The minimum com-
5 pensation for any probation officer shall be twenty-
6 five hundred dollars per annum.
