By Mr. Miles of Boston, petition of Percy C. Charnock relative to the taking effect in the city of Boston of the law regulating the hours of duty of permanent members of fire departments in certain cities and towns. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAKING EFFECT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON OF A CERTAIN LAW REGULATING THE HOURS OF DUTY OF PERMANENT MEMBERS OF FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 436 of the acts
2 of 1946, as amended by chapter 597 of the acts of
3 said year, is hereby further amended by striking out
4 the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the
5 following sentence:— If a majority of the votes cast
6 on said question is in the affirmative, said section
7 fifty-eight B of said chapter forty-eight shall take
8 effect in said city six months thereafter.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
