AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS TO SERVE IN A CONFIDENTIAL CAPACITY IN THE DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by chapter 512 of the acts of 1941, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the word "com-
4 mission" in the sixth line the words: — , each commis-
5 sioner of the department of banking and insurance, —
6 so as to read as follows:— *Section 7.* Each officer,
7 board and commission having supervision and control
8 of an executive or administrative department, in-
9 cluding each commissioner of the commission on
10 administration and finance and the officer in charge
11 of the division of personnel and standardization of
12 said commission, each commissioner of the depart-
13 ment of banking and insurance, the state superin-
14 tendent of buildings, the alcoholic beverages control

15 commission and the state racing commission, but
16 not including the several boards serving in the division
17 of registration of the department of civil service and
18 registration, may appoint and remove a person to
19 serve as a confidential secretary. Such appointment
20 shall be in accordance with the provisions of sections
21 forty-five to fifty, inclusive, of this chapter and shall
22 be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one.
