AN ACT TO RELIEVE CERTAIN PERSONS OF THE PAYMENT OF REAL ESTATE TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after paragraph 17, section 5 thereof, the
- 3 following new paragraph, designated as 17A:—
- 4 17A. Real property to the amount of eight thou-
- 5 sand dollars of a widow, or a person above the age of
- 6 sixty-five, who are legal residents of the Common-
- 7 wealth, and whose net income is less than two thou-
- 8 sand dollars per year, and who have paid real property
- 9 taxes on such property for a period of twenty years.
