AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF DETECTIVES IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 22 of the General Laws, as ap-
2 pearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end the following:—
4 Detectives appointed by the commissioner hereunder
5 shall perform their duties in the division of state
6 police under the direction and supervision of a chief
7 of detectives who shall be subject to the provisions of
8 chapter thirty-one and who shall be appointed from
9 among the detective inspectors and detectives of the
10 division of state police after competitive examination
11 in accordance with civil service rules.
