AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SHELTER AT THE FIELDS CORNER SECTION OF THE BOSTON ELEVATED RAILWAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The trustees of the Boston Elevated Railway are
2 authorized to construct a shelter at the corners of
3 Dorchester avenue and Park street in the Fields Cor-
4 ner section of Dorchester for the accommodation of
5 the passengers who use the Adams street and Neponset
6 avenue lines, and the Dorchester avenue line of the
7 Boston Elevated Railway.
