AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF WHOLESALERS'
AND IMPORTERS' LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEV-
ERAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 18 of chapter 138 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as most recently amended by sections 7
3 and 8 of chapter 542 of the acts of 1943, is hereby
4 amended by striking out the last sentence of the
5 fourth paragraph.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 18, as so amended, is
2 hereby further amended by adding at the end the fol-
3 lowing paragraph: —

4 No licensee under section fifteen, and no person who
5 is an officer or director of any corporation or associa-
6 tion, or a partner in any partnership, licensed under
7 said section fifteen, or who has any direct or indirect
8 proprietary interest, except pursuant to an extension
9 of credit in the usual course of business, in any such
10 corporation, association or partnership, shall be the
11 holder of any license under this section.
