AN ACT PLACING THE STATE PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING GUARDS IN GROUP B IN THE STATE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The subdivision entitled Group B of paragraph  
2 (2) (g) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,  
3 as appearing in section 1 of chapter 658 of the acts of  
4 1945, is hereby amended by inserting after the word  
5 "police" in line 3 the words: — , public works build-  
6 ing guards, — so as to read as follows: — *Group B.* —  
7 Members of police and fire departments not classified  
8 in Group A, members of the police force of the metro-  
9 politan district commission, capitol police, public  
10 works building guards, conservation officers paid as  
11 such, district fire wardens, coastal wardens in the de-  
12 partment of conservation, and employees of the  
13 commonwealth and of any county, regardless of any  
14 official classification, whose regular and major duties  
15 require them to have the care and custody of prisoners  
16 or insane persons or of defective delinquents at the  
17 state farm.
