The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES, AT THEIR REQUEST, AFTER SERVING TWENTY YEARS OR MORE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any employee of the state, or any city or county
- 2 thereof, after serving twenty years or more, shall
- 3 have the privilege, at their request, to be retired and
- 4 be paid their pension.
