AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN ANNUITIES TO TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (a) of paragraph (1) of section 13 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in sec-
3 tion 1 of chapter 658 of the acts of 1945, is hereby
4 amended by adding at the end thereof the following
5 words:—, except that such payments to teachers
6 shall be due and payable monthly,—so that said
7 subdivision shall read as follows:—(a) Payments under
8 any annuity, pension or retirement allowance pro-
9 vided for under this chapter and in effect on December
10 thirty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-five, shall con-
11 tinue to be due and payable in the same amounts,
12 under the same conditions and at the same intervals
13 of time as were in effect on such date, except that such
14 payments to teachers shall be due and payable
15 monthly.
