### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

1 *Whereas*, The city of Chelsea was authorized by  
2 chapter one hundred and seven of the acts of nineteen  
3 hundred and forty-six to convey to the common-  
4 wealth by deed, without consideration, a certain parcel  
5 of park land, so called, containing 462,719 square feet  
6 and did convey said land to the commonwealth; and  
7 *Whereas*, It was the understanding that certain fill  
8 contained on said land would be given to the city or  
9 used to fill in city land; and  
10 *Whereas*, Said fill was not used in accordance with  
11 the understanding but was removed from the land by  
12 the commonwealth; therefore be it  
13 *Resolved*, That in order to fulfill a moral obligation,  
14 the commonwealth pay to the city of Chelsea out of  
15 the state treasury, subject to appropriation, the sum  
16 of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars to compensate it for the value  
17 of the fill so removed by the commonwealth.
