MEMORANDUM OF COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION PURSUANT TO GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 7, AS AMENDED, WITH RESPECT TO PETITION OF WILLIAM L. BAXTER FOR LEGISLATION TO REVIVE THE GRAHAM COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONVEYING AND TRANSFERRING CERTAIN PROPERTY OF SAID CORPORATION.

JANUARY 28, 1947.

*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.*

The above-named petition was transmitted to me by the Clerk of the House January 15, 1947.

The Graham Company was organized as a business corporation on December 30, 1933. It was dissolved by chapter 54 of the Acts of 1936. As the time has expired within which the corporation may be revived under General Laws, chapter 155, section 56, the object sought by the petition can only be accomplished by an act of the Legislature. The fee of \$25 required by General Laws, chapter 3, section 7, has been received.

It is suggested that if the Legislature acts favorably upon the bill, a provision be inserted limiting the duration of corporate existence in view of the fact that the corporation seeks revival solely for the purpose of a specific act. For a revival of a similar nature, reference may be had to Acts of 1945, chapter 270.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

### AN ACT REVIVING THE GRAHAM COMPANY.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would  
2 delay the corporation revived thereby in resuming the  
3 exercise of its former corporate powers, therefore it is  
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for  
5 the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 The Graham Company, a corporation dissolved by  
2 section one, chapter fifty-four, of the acts of nineteen  
3 hundred and thirty-six, is hereby revived for the sole  
4 and specified purpose of conveying and transferring  
5 certain property of the corporation.
