AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY REINSTATEMENT,  
FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES ONLY, OF JOHN M. DEVER  
AS A MEMBER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE  
CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. John M. Dever, a former member of  
2 the police department of the city of Boston, who was  
3 separated from the service of said department on April  
4 ninth, nineteen hundred and forty-five, after serving  
5 therein for seventeen years and eight months, may be  
6 reinstated in said department without examination;  
7 provided, that such reinstatement shall be for the sole  
8 purpose of retiring him under the appropriate provi-  
9 sions of sections fifty-six to sixty, inclusive, of chapter  
10 thirty-two of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the city  
3 council of said city, subject to the provisions of its  
4 charter, but not otherwise.
