AN ACT PERMITTING FISHING IN WATERS OF THE METROPOLITAN WATER SYSTEM IN THE TOWN OF SOUTHBOROUGH AND THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH FROM ANY PUBLIC WAY ADJOINING SUCH WATERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, fishing in waters in the town of Southborough
3 and the city of Marlborough, used or held for water
4 supply purposes of the metropolitan water district,
5 from any public way adjoining such waters, is hereby
6 permitted, subject otherwise to the provisions of law
7 regulating fishing.
