RESOLVE VALIDATING THE ACTS OF LILLIAN G. BAKER OF BOSTON AS A NOTARY PUBLIC.

1 *Resolved*, That the acts of Lillian G. Baker of Boston
2 as a notary public between July fourteenth, nineteen
3 hundred and forty-six, and February nineteenth,
4 nineteen hundred and forty-seven, both dates inclu-
5 sive, in so far as the same may have been invalid by
6 reason of the fact that, upon the change of her name
7 from Lillian G. Reingold, she failed to re-register
8 under her new name and pay to the state secretary
9 a fee of one dollar as required by section thirteen of
10 chapter thirty of the General Laws, are hereby con-
11 firmed and made valid.
