AN ACT PERMITTING THE LATE FILING OF CERTIFICATES OF NOMINATION AND NOMINATION PAPERS FOR THE ANNUAL TOWN ELECTION OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHBOROUGH IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Certificates of nomination and nomi-
2 nation papers of candidates for town offices in the
3 town of Southborough to be elected at the annual
4 town election of said town in the current year may be
5 filed with the town clerk during the periods prescribed
6 by section ten of chapter fifty-three of the General
7 Laws for the filing of such certificates and nomina-
8 tion papers, respectively, in any town which has not
9 accepted section one hundred and three A of chapter
10 fifty-four of the General Laws, notwithstanding the
11 fact that the town of Southborough has accepted said
12 section one hundred and three A.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
