AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE MORE PARTICULAR CERTIFICATION OF NAMES OF NOMINATORS UPON NOMINATION PAPERS USED IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AND DISPENSING WITH THE REQUIREMENT THAT SUCH CERTIFICATION BE SWORN TO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 53 of chapter 486 of the acts
2 of 1909, as most recently amended by section 1 of
3 chapter 472 of the acts of 1941, is hereby further
4 amended by striking out all following the form of
5 ACCEPTANCE OF NOMINATION by the nominee, and
6 inserting in place thereof the following:
