In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO NIGHT LABOR FOR WOMEN OVER TWENTY-ONE IN MANUFACTURING AND MECHANICAL ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING ON MULTIPLE SHIFTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 59, as amended by section 1
3 of Chapter 357 of the acts of 1947, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following: —

5 *Section 59.* No person, and no agent or officer of
6 a person, shall employ a female in any capacity in
7 manufacturing or mechanical establishments before
8 six o'clock in the morning or after eleven o'clock in
9 the evening, except that in any such establishment
10 which operates on multiple shifts, a woman over
11 twenty-one may be employed until twelve o'clock
12 midnight. Whoever violates any provision of this
13 section shall be punished by a fine of not less than
14 twenty or more than fifty dollars.
