AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE APPOINTMENT AND PROMOTION OF POLICEMEN AND FIREMEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 6 of chapter 704
3 of the acts of 1945, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out in the twenty-first to twenty-third lines,
5 inclusive, the words:— provided, that such appli-
6 cants shall not be eligible to take any such examination
7 unless they have been employed in such lower ranks
8 for at least one year.
