AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE INCLUSION OF THE PERIOD OF CERTAIN PATRIOTIC SERVICES RENDERED BY SPECIAL JUSTICES OF DISTRICT COURTS IN COMPUTING THEIR LENGTH OF SERVICE AS SUCH SPECIAL JUSTICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section sixty-five B of chapter thirty-two of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter
3 three hundred and ninety-eight of the acts of nine-
4 teen hundred and forty-three, is hereby further
5 amended by adding at the end thereof the following
6 sentence:— His service as a member of the armed
7 forces of the United States, or as an officer or em-
8 ployee of any agency of the federal government,
9 during World War II, so called, shall not be con-
10 sidered as having interrupted the tenure of office of
11 any person as such special justice, and the period of
12 any such service shall be included as a part of the
13 ten year period of service as a special justice herein
14 made prerequisite to his right to a pension.
