### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PENSIONS OF SPECIAL JUSTICES OF DISTRICT COURTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 65B of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in chapter 398 of the acts of 1943, is hereby  
3 amended by adding at the end the following sentence:  
4 — The period of time during which he served as a  
5 member of the armed forces of the United States or  
6 as an officer or employee of any agency of the federal  
7 government to which he has given full time during  
8 World War II, so called, shall be excluded in com-  
9 puting the years or other period of service under this  
10 section.

Approved by the Senate on the 12th day of June 1891.
