To accompany the petition of William C. Geary for legislation relative to the retirement of certain employees of cities and towns. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any employee of any city or town who has been a
2 member of the contributory retirement system of
3 such city or town during its existence and who has
4 been employed by such city or town for twenty-five
5 years or more, and who has reached the age of fifty-
6 five, shall, upon application, be retired, with an al-
7 lowance of not less than one half of his compensation
8 at the date of his retirement.
