AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING STATE REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS ON ACCOUNT OF OLD AGE ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8 of chapter 118A of the General Laws, as
- 2 amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the
- 3 end the following paragraph:—
- 4 Reimbursement by the commonwealth under this
- 5 section shall be made within ninety days from the date
- 6 of the receipt by the department from the city or town
- 7 of the account against the commonwealth for allow-
- 8 ances, as above provided, and all moneys so received
- 9 by any city or town as such reimbursement shall be
- 10 expended by it solely for old age assistance.
