AN ACT RELATIVE TO PRINTING RECORDS TRANSMITTED TO
THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT IN APPELLATE PROCEED-
INGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 135 of chapter 231 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and as most
3 recently amended by section one of chapter 187 of the
4 acts of 1941, is hereby further amended by adding at
5 the end thereof the following new paragraph: —

6 The record which is to be printed shall be printed
7 by a printer designated by the party having the obli-
8 gation to cause the necessary papers to be prepared.
9 The printer, before entering upon the performance of
10 his duties, shall give bond, payable to the common-
11 wealth of Massachusetts, in the sum of one thousand
12 dollars, conditioned to perform faithfully the duties of
