AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO RENDER
OPINIONS TO VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS ON LAWS
AFFECTING THE WELFARE OR AFFAIRS OF VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Upon petition of two or more veteran organizations
2 for an interpretation of any law affecting the welfare
3 of a veteran, or any law dealing with veterans' affairs;
4 the attorney general shall be empowered to render an
5 opinion on said question to the veterans' organizations
6 and in a like manner as such opinions are rendered
7 to department heads.
