AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION AT THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The board of trustees of the Soldiers Home in
2 Massachusetts is hereby authorized and directed to
3 make provisions for the addition of a wing, containing
4 not less than twenty-five beds, at the Soldiers' Home,
5 located at Chelsea, and that said wing is to be used
6 exclusively for women veterans, and that hospital
7 and domiciliary care shall be provided in the same
8 manner as that provided for male veterans.
