To accompany the petition of Joseph A. Melley for legislation relative to the location of machines used for grinding hamburger and other foods. Public Health.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LOCATION OF MACHINES USED FOR GRINDING HAMBURGER AND OTHER FOODS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 98 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 56A, inserted by chapter 60
3 of the acts of 1941, the following section:—

4 *Section 56B.* A machine or other device when
5 used for the purpose of grinding hamburger or other
6 foods when sold at retail, shall be so placed that the
7 grinding operation may be observed by the public.
