AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ABOLITION OF A CERTAIN
GRADE CROSSING IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The department of public works is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to abolish the present grade crossing
3 over the location of the Boston and Albany Railroad
4 Company in the town of Framingham at Concord
5 street. For said purposes, said department may ex-
6 pend such sums, not exceeding, in the aggregate,
7 dollars, as may hereafter be appropriated
8 from the Highway Fund.
