AN ACT TO AMEND THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT
BY FURTHER REGULATING THE EXAMINATION OF THE
INJURED EMPLOYEE BY AN IMPARTIAL PHYSICIAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter one hundred
2 and fifty-two of the General Laws, as amended, is
3 hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence
4 the following sentence: — The insurer shall have the
5 right to file with the physician a copy of its version
6 of the facts concerning the alleged injury.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
