AN ACT REGULATING THE PUBLICATION OF CITATIONS ISSUED BY PROBATE COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 It is hereby provided that in cases where publica-
2 tion of citations issued by probate courts is necessary
3 under the provisions of chapter 192, chapter 208,
4 chapter 215 and chapter 217 of the General Laws, as
5 amended, such publication shall be made in a news-
6 paper published in the city or town in which the de-
7 ceased or persons most at interest reside; and in the
8 event that no newspaper is published in said city or
9 town, then publication may be made in a newspaper
10 in a city or town adjacent to or nearest to said city
11 or town of the deceased or parties most at interest.
