To accompany the petition of John E. Powers that certain veterans be authorized to take examinations for registration as embalmers and funeral directors without having the required educational requirements. Public Health.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN VETERANS TO TAKE EXAMINATIONS FOR REGISTRATION AS EMBALMERS AND FUNERAL DIRECTORS THOUGH NOT HAVING REQUIRED EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any veteran of World War II whose discharge or
2 other separation from the service was other than dis-
3 honorable may, at any time prior to January first,
4 nineteen hundred and fifty, upon his own request,
5 take any examination for registration as embalmer or
6 funeral director, despite the fact that he has not the
7 required educational qualifications established by law
8 as a prerequisite to taking such examination.
