

SENATE No. 539

To accompany the petition of Melvin G. Rogers and others (county commissioners of Middlesex County) that provision be made for additional toilets and for a sewage disposal system for the Walden Pond State Reservation. Counties.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL TOILETS AND FOR A SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM FOR THE WALDEN POND STATE RESERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing additional
2 toilets and constructing a sewage disposal system for
3 the Walden pond state reservation, the county com-
4 missioners of Middlesex county, as trustees of said
5 reservation, may take by eminent domain under the
6 provisions of chapter seventy-nine of the General
7 Laws, or may acquire by purchase or otherwise, such
8 land as may be necessary, and may construct thereon
9 or on the present reservation the necessary buildings
10 and sewage disposal system, and may furnish and
11 equip the same and do all things necessary for said
12 purpose.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose aforesaid, the county
2 treasurer of said county, with the approval of the
3 county commissioners, may borrow from time to
4 time, on the credit of said county, such sums as may
5 be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate sixty
6 thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the
7 county therefor which shall bear on their face the
8 words "Walden Pond State Reservation Loan, Acts
9 of 1947". Each authorized issue shall constitute a
10 separate loan and such loan shall be payable in not
11 more than five years from their dates. Such bonds or
12 notes shall be signed by the treasurer of the county
13 and countersigned by a majority of the county com-
14 missioners. The county may sell the said securities
15 at public or private sale upon such terms and condi-
16 tions as the county commissioners may deem proper,
17 but not for less than their par value. Indebtedness
18 incurred under this act shall, except as herein pro-
19 vided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General
20 Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance, during the current year, by the county
3 commissioners of the county of Middlesex, but not
4 otherwise.
